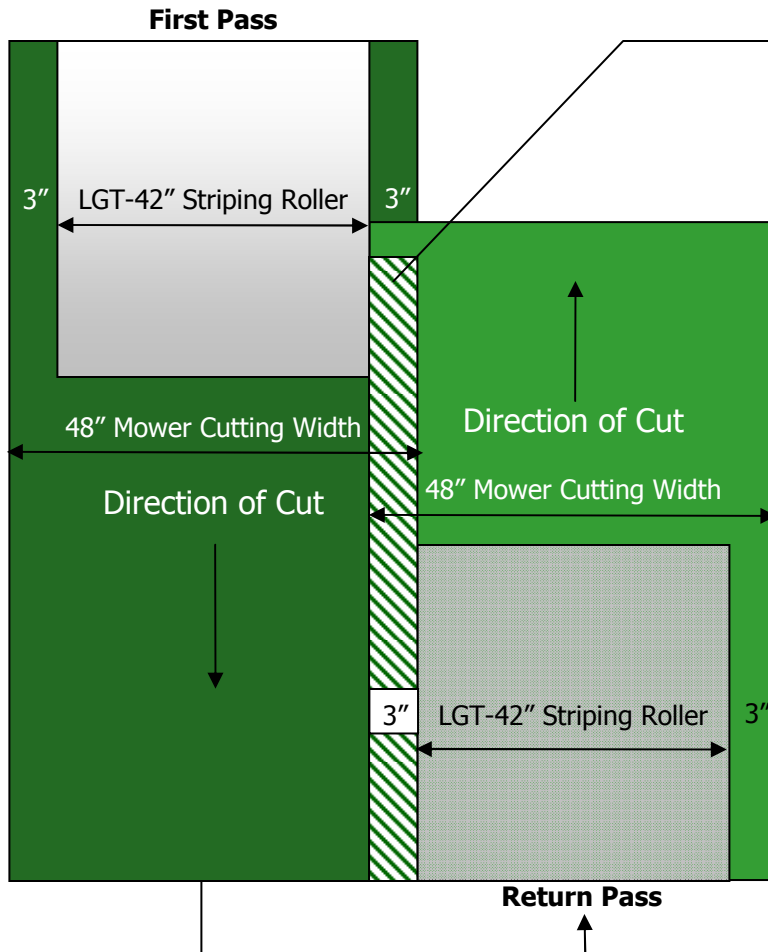




- **Example:** John Deere lawn/garden tractor series mower with 48" mowing deck.



Mower deck overlap area [defined by hash marks] should not be rolled. If rolled in one direction (first pass), then rolled in a second direction (return pass), the grass *could* remain standing up. Stripes appear more natural when this area is not rolled.

Each user should first determine how many inches they typically overlap their deck prior to selecting the appropriate roller width. To create wide, vibrant stripes, the operator should attempt to limit the amount of overlap to 2"-4". In doing so a roller width that is approximately 4"-8" smaller than the mower deck would be considered most appropriate.

In this example we would recommend LGT42 for a JD mower with 48" mowing deck.

- **Note that all dimensions are approximate and intended to explain how to best determine the proper roller width. Exact dimensions are not required.**
